## KKNK celebrates festival in Oudtshoorn again in 2022

After an absence of two years, Oudtshoorn is shaking its feathers to welcome festival-goers from 29 March to 3 April 2022 at the 26th Klein Karoo National Arts Festival (KKNK).

"We are delighted with the possibility of being able to celebrate in Oudtshoorn again after two years. Although we have offered lots of digital entertainment to festival goers lately, while the festival could not take place, there is nothing better than experiencing the KKNK in Oudtshoorn's scenic beauty and with Klein Karoo hospitality in person." So says Crispin Sonn, chairman of the KKNK board.

"We are very excited and ready to welcome and entertain festival-goers and artists from far and wide in Oudtshoorn. As usual at all events, strict Covid-19 measures will be applied, so that we can look after the safety of festival-goers, artists and staff and socialize in a responsible way, "says Sonn.

"It is not easy to present a festival, where people have to deal with each other in close contact and still apply the safety factor, without us having to comply with certain key measures. This includes implementing a vaccination mandate that is both in agreement with and in support of the current national movement, and that is also supported by our sponsors. Our festival-goers love the arts and we have no doubt that they will understand how important this requirement is - which allows us to have a festival at all, "adds Sonn.

Hugo Theart, artistic director of the KKNK, says the prospect of welcoming festival-goers, sponsors, artists, partners and other visitors to Oudtshoorn is a privilege. "We look forward to celebrating art in the heart of the Little Karoo again. It is wonderful for us to look at the festival with new eyes. Most of the popular elements are presented, but everything is packaged in a new way to create new experiences that can be presented safely within Covid-19 guidelines. We invite you to come and breathe in the Little Karoo at the end of March."

According to Theart, the festival program will be launched by the end of February, with ticket sales opening immediately thereafter. "Tickets to performances are limited due to the safety measures.
